




How is VIMGA organized?



Two structures serve VIMGA’s membership: the Board of Directors and committees. Board members are all Directors. Under the Societies Act they have specific duties and responsibilities. Committee members have specific duties within each committee structure, and make recommendations to the board.

Board of Directors

This is the governing body of VIMGA which meets monthly (except July, August, & December) to administer its activities. Each board member is required to have, and be familiar with, the current member manual, forms, and the VIMGA constitution and bylaws. Members can attend meetings as a non-voting member-at-large. The Board of Directors are elected every 2 years.



Committees & Positions

In addition to the board, VIMGA functions through standing committees, ad hoc committees and appointed positions. Committees may be active or not depending on the current organizational needs as determined by the board of directors and membership. Interns in their 2nd year are able to volunteer in many committees. More specific information is available on the Member’s website.
