




What is VIMGA?

PQN:

Parksville, Qualicum, Nanooose + Qualicum Bay and Port Alberni

NANAIMO:

+Yellow Point, Lantzville, and Gabriola and Protection Islands

COWICHAN:

+ Ladysmith down to Mill Bay, SaltSpring and Thetis Islands

VIMGA is divided into four geographic Districts. The Districts work collaboratively within VIMGA. The entire membership meets 3 times a year: Spring Education Day (SED), Annual General Meeting (AGM), and a summer picnic. District meetings vary, but generally occur every couple of months. Each District is unique in both its membership and its community needs. The Victoria area is covered by the Victoria Master Gardeners.
